The pre-auction meeting will be held virtually on the Microsoft Teams platform. A QR code for access is included at the end of this notice. The link will also be provided through the REPSEL platform.

Auction documents, such as plans, specifications, and special and general conditions, will be available in digital format. These documents will become part of the auction documents for the resulting contract. To obtain them, you must access the new **Electronic Registry of Suppliers and Online Auctions (hereinafter REPSEL)** at <https://caguas.gov.pr/subastasonline>. After creating your user account and completing the registration process, in addition to having access to the documents for this auction, you will receive notifications of all future auctions held by the Municipality. If you have any problems with accessing this platform, you can contact the Purchasing and Auctions Office at 787-653-8833, ext. 1990/1900/1960.

Through REPSEL, all bidders will upload and submit, in PDF digital format, their proposals and any other required document, in or before Wednesday, April 29, 2026, at 3:00pm. All proposals will be encrypted within the platform for security and assurance of the processes until the day of opening. The opening of the bids will require that three (3) members of the Auction Board authorize the action on the system, after 10:00 a.m. of the day of the opening. After this moment, all proposals will be available through the portal for revision from all bidders. Questions and answers must be submitted through REPSEL by selecting the "Add Questions" box. Bidders must complete Field 1 by selecting their company and Field 2 to submit their question.

Each proposal and/or tender must be accompanied by a bond (Bid Bond) for 5% of the total cost of the bid. This may be satisfied via certified check or money order in the name of the Finance Director, Autonomous Municipality of Caguas, or through insurance from a company registered with the Puerto Rico Insurance Commissioner and authorized to operate in Puerto Rico.

These acquisition, service and construction auctions may be financed with municipal or federal funds (FEMA, HUD, CDBG, CDBG-DR, CDBG-DR / City Revitalization, Federal Transportation Administration, FTA, among others) or combination of these.

At the moment of contracting it will be required it be registered at the System of Awards Management (SAM). Registration evidence must be provided or that the processes have started. To obtain more information please go to <https://www.sam.gov/SAM>.

The Auction Board reserves the right to reject any or all submitted proposals or award the bid under the most favorable conditions for the Municipality of Caguas. It also reserves the right to cancel the award before the contract is formalized or a purchase order is issued, without liability to the Municipality.
